<small>REASON WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT</small> Pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, as amended, and pursuant to Section 15332 "In-Fill Development Projects," the project is classified as a Class 32 Categorical Exemption given that the; a) project is consistent with the applicable general plan policies as well as with applicable zoning designation and regulations; b) the proposed development occurs within city limits on a project site of no more than five acres substantially surrounded by urban uses; c) the project site has no value as habitat for endangered, rare or threatened species; d) approval of the project would not result in any significant effects relating to traffic, noise, air quality, or water quality; and e) the site can be adequately served by all required utilities and public services. In addition, none of the exceptions to the categorical exemption apply under Section 15300.2, as 1) there is no cumulative impact of successive projects of the same type; 2) there is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances; 3) the proposed site is not located on a scenic highway, hazardous waste site or near a historical resource. Accordingly, no further environmental review is required.
