

GALLERY CONCORD

Gallery Concord is a nonprofit, educational gallery, managed and staffed by selected members of the California Watercolor Association with help from community volunteers. Funding is provided by member's dues and by a grant from the City of Concord for operation of the gallery.

Showcasing a wide variety of water media paintings, the gallery also features the work of a different media artist and sculptor each quarter. Each day an "Artist in Residence" is available to talk about the art while working on his or her own projects.

Quarterly receptions are open to the public and special programs are held for the public to view new work and meet the artists.

Fifteen percent of all sales is donated to CWA's Outreach Program. This provides funding for art demonstrations and fine art supplies to schools. Free visits by school children to the gallery are encouraged. Call the gallery to arrange a time to visit with your group.

To become a gallery artist member: you must be a member of CWA. Submit photos or JPEGs of your work to the gallery. A panel will review the work in conjunction with the needs of the gallery.

To become a community volunteer: contact the gallery and leave you name and phone number. We'd love to find you a place in the gallery. Gallery volunteers usually sit once a month. You may use watercolor materials while in the gallery. The on site "Artist in Residence" often gives valuable painting tips.
